

Variety Sweet	Colour	Fruit Size (cm)	Disease Resistances
BULLSWEET F1	Red	20 x 5	HR: TMV
<p>Bullsweet is an outstanding bullhorn type capsicum suited to all capsicum timeslots. It has a vigorous plant providing good cover. Fruit are a tapered bullhorn, measuring 20 cm long by 5cm at the shoulder and turn from a dark green to red. Bullsweet has high yield potential</p>			
MATADOR F1	Red	20 x 5.5	IR: TSWV
<p>Matador is a red bullhorn type with a vigorous bush. Fruit are 20 x 5.5cm in size, uniform, straight and thick walled. Matador is highly productive and is suited to late autumn to spring planting in northern areas and spring and summer planting in southern areas.</p>

ANKO F1	Red	15 x 9	HR: TMV & TSWV
<p>Lamuyo type capsicum 15 x 9cm, green to dark red. Suitable for supported low tech greenhouse or shadehouse growing.</p>

Variety Chilli / Habanero	Colour	Fruit Size (cm)	Disease Resistances
HABAHOT F1	Orange	6 x 3	
<p>Habahot is a habanero chilli with a semi compact plant and dark green leaves. Fruit are orange when ripe, wrinkled. Habanero chillis are amongst the hottest chillis in the world, and Habahot offers high yields of pungent aromatic chillis with a pungency level of 300 000 Scoville units.</p>			
Chilli / Jalapeno			
POPEYE F1	Green	8 x 3	HR: Xcv 1-3
<p>Popeye is a large jalapeno type chilli with a compact sturdy plant, affording good cover to the fruit, with a high yield potential. Dark green and shiny with thick walls with minimal crazing. Popeye is highly suitable for harvesting green, for the fresh or processing markets.</p>			
Chilli / Cayenne			
PERI PERI F1	Red	14.5 x 2.5	IR: PVY, CMV
<p>Cayenne type chilli dark green to bright shiny red, 14.5 cm long by 2.5 cm at shoulder. Good pungency.</p>			
SCORCHER F1	Red	14 x 2	
<p>Cayenne type chilli with a compact plant and high yield potential. Suited to open field or greenhouse production. Dark red and very firm with thick walls and low to medium pungency.</p>			



DISEASE KEY DEFINITIONS

HR: Highly resistant plant varieties would highly restrict the growth and development of the specified pest or pathogen under normal growing conditions and pest pressure when compared to susceptible varieties. These plant varieties may, however, exhibit some symptoms or damage under heavy pest pressure or stressful growing conditions.

IR: Intermediately resistant plant varieties would restrict the growth and development of the specified pest or pathogen. The plant variety may however exhibit a greater range or degree of symptoms when compared to a highly resistant variety. Intermediately resistant plant varieties will still show less severe symptoms or disease damage than susceptible plant varieties when the crop is grown under similar environmental conditions and is subjected to the same disease or pest pressure.

TMV - Tobacco Mosaic (*Tobacco Mosaic Virus*)

TSWV - Tomato Spotted Wilt (*Tomato Spotted Wilt Virus*)

Xcv - Bacterial Spot (*Xanthomonas campestris pv. vesicatoria*)

PVY - Potato Y (*Potato Y Virus*)

CMV - Cucumber Mosaic (*Cucumber Mosaic Virus*)
